

AUDITIONS FOR *So Much to Tell You*

Description

Scarred, literally, by her past, Marina has withdrawn into silence. Then, at her new boarding school, she is set the task of writing a diary by her English teacher, and finds a way of expressing her thoughts and feelings, and of exploring the traumatic events that have caused her distress. Through Marina's diary we gain an insight into life on her dormitory, and her difficult relationship with her father, who injured her in an angry moment. Eventually, Marina makes tentative friendships and, in a moving denouement, is reconciled with her father.

Characters

Marina the Diarist/Marina the Student – (14+) refuses to talk to other girls, speaks directly to audience through diary entries, has been physically and emotionally scarred by her parents

Sophie – **Loud and bubbly, gets into trouble, deeply insecure**

Lisa – **Nordic looking, strong, quiet yet popular**

Kate – **Loud, very interested in boys**

Cathy – **Gentle, befriends Marina**

Tracey – **Plain, hard working, taken for granted by the others**

Emma – **From Hong Kong, intelligent, wealthy background**

Ann – **Nice, pretty, befriends Marina**

Rikki – **student from another dormitory, popular, sarcastic**

Jodi – **Prefect, slightly older student, responsible**

Mrs Graham – **housemistress, bossy (40+)**

Mr Lindell or Mrs Lindell – **English Teacher, compassionate (25-40)**

Miss Curzon – **boarding house tutor, can't control the girls (25-40)**

Male Figure representing Marina's father – **only one speaking line (45+)**
